Curriculum and Professional Development

Our February 16 Professional Development day has a focus on mental health. Speakers from NAMI (National Association of Mental Illness) will speak with our teachers. The presentation will give an overview of mental illness, treatment, stigma, impact, and recovery. Our goal is to educate our teachers so they are more aware and prepared to deal with students struggling with mental health issues.

As part of our literacy initiative we are making arrangements with Erin Loritz of CESA 6 to do a fishbowl training at each of our elementary schools. Erin will demonstrate a lesson with a variety of classrooms at our schools while teachers have the opportunity to observe and process afterwards.

We are in the process of ordering sample instructional materials for literacy for early childhood through grade 6.
