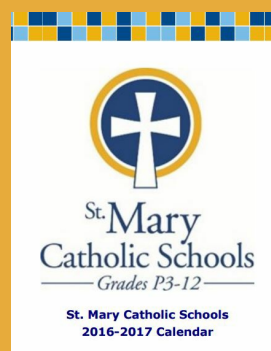


SMCS 2016-17 Calendar Updates

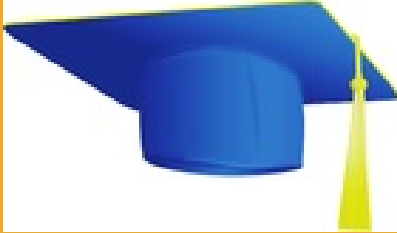

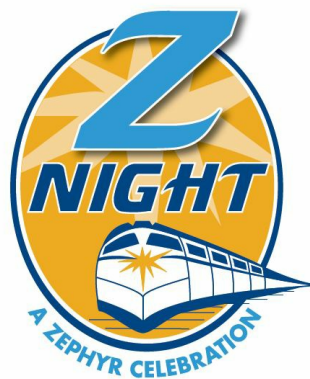


New! Scrip Update
