C. Athletic Director Report HS – Adam Bates

- Girls Tennis team were Conference Champs. None of the girls advanced to sectionals.
- Cross Country
 - o Conference meet held in Mishicot on October 13.
 - Sectionals are Saturday, October 22 @ Amherst.
- Boys Soccer plays @ home vs. Oostburg.
- Girls volleyball
 - SMCHS volleyball team received a 4-seed in the playoffs and will be hosting Amherst (the 5-seed) in a Regional Quarterfinal Match on Tuesday, October 18 at 7:00 p.m.
 - o Regular season wraps up on Saturday, October 15 @ Howard's Grove.
- Boys Soccer seed meeting is Saturday, October 15. Update: The boys' soccer team

<u>Concessions – Melissa Uhlenbrauck</u>

- Rachel Brown asked if they could have their own supplies for concessions. Melissa has taken care of this.
- Football will use up pizzas and pretzels.
- Volleyball Regionals is Tuesday, October 18. A limited concessions menu will be offered.

<u>Volunteer – Pam Seidl</u>

- Pam Seidl is the compiling volunteer hours.
 - o HS: 625 slots of which 370 were worked.
 - o MS: 615 slots of which 194 were worked.
- A survey was sent out to parents to determine what they prefer volunteer schedule by sport, by date, by high school sports and by middle school sports. The overwhelming response was by sport so parents if they wanted could work for their kid's sports activity.

Booster Backer – Tara Gagne

- It was asked that we reach out to alumni parents and recent alumni to ask for Booster Club or ad sponsorships. It was felt that many gave in the past and may have given again but were not asked. This is being looked into.
- All Booster Backer chairs and blankets were delivered. Extra items are available for purchase.
- Order forms for basketball will be out next week. Youth sizes will be added to the order form. Orders are due November 4, 2016.
- Middle School kids can order a warm-up t-shirt and can wear it to school on game days.
- 10% off coupons were handed out on the parade route. It seemed to help sales. \$1,000 in sales that evening. Offer 10% off again for Middle School night.
- Pennants were successful, especially nice on homecoming. Consider doing something every year as a take away.
