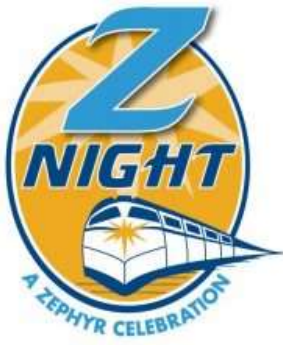


School Opens at 7:15am
