
The American Legion's Badger Girls and Boys State program is a non-partisan, practical experience designed to develop leadership and pride in American citizens, educate citizens about our system of government, instill a greater understanding of American traditions and stimulate a desire to maintain our democratic government processes.

Most of each day is spent engaging in the various activities of government. The citizens formed a hypothetical 51st American state and are divided into two political parties. They develop their own party platforms and formulate their own issues. Citizens "learn

by doing” as they function on city, county and state levels by electing officials in the manner prescribed by regular election procedures and conducting business on those levels. Every participant is encouraged to engage in some level of the governmental process.
