CAPP Summer Classes

UW-Oshkosh is offering two CAPP classes open to students entering their Junior or Senior year of high school. Both are 1 college credit, 4 week, online classes from June 11-July 6. Cost is \$100 per class. Students may take one or both.

Final Transcripts


Please remember to submit your final transcript request in Naviance for the college/university you plan to attend. Directions were emailed to all seniors on May 9th.

Requesting transcripts is the responsibility of the student and should be done soon after the course is complete to avoid any delay in college/university course registration. Failure to report earned credit may have serious repercussions.
