The SMCHS Softball team received a 3-seed in the playoffs and will host Reedsville, the 6-seed, in the Regional Semifinal game on Tuesday, May 22 at 4:30 p.m. If they win, they would next play on Friday, May 25. The location and opponent of that game will depend on the outcome of other games in the bracket. SMCHS would either host St. Mary's Springs or Gibraltar/Washington Island, or SMCHS would play at Algoma.

The SMCHS Baseball team received a 1-seed in the playoffs and got a bye in the Regional Quarterfinal round. SMCHS will host the Regional Semifinal game on Tuesday, May 29 at 4:30 p.m. and will play the winner of the Reedsville/Shiocton game.
