### **SMC Students Earn Eagle Scout Award**

SMC Juniors **Jack Hageman, Nick Purcell and Ethan Unruh** recently earned the highest advancement ranking in boy scouting--Eagle Scout--a rank only six percent of Boy Scouts ever achieve. To achieve the Boy Scouts of America Eagle rank, each scout progressed through five ranks between the ages of 11-17, earned at least 21 merit badges, participated in a rigorous scoutmaster conference, held a leadership role, planned, developed and implemented a service project, and completed a lengthy application and review process. The young men were honored for completing their service projects and achieving Eagle Scout rank at the Court of Honor on **Monday, April 23**. The Eagle Scout service projects completed were:

**Purcell (left)** organized and hosted a community collection of shoes, sunglasses and calculators for St. Margaret Mary parishioners to deliver to children in Haiti while on a Mission there in January.

**Unruh (middle)** built a 9-Square game out of PVC pipe for use by SPIRITUS ministries in Neenah to use on their youth retreats.

**Hageman (right)** raised funds for blanket supplies to make 65 fleece-tie blankets for premature babies in the neonatal intensive care unit and pediatric patients at Children's Hospital.
