### **St. Mary Catholic High School to Offer 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Visit Day and Shadow Days**

(Neenah) St. Mary Catholic High School (SMCHS) will welcome students for 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Visit Day on Thursday, September 27, 2018. Students will have the opportunity to meet current SMCHS students and faculty/staff, tour the school, and learn more about student life, academics, co-curriculars and the school's one-to-one laptop program. The visit day concludes with every student receiving a Zephyrs Class of 2023 sweatshirt.

Students will also be invited for a future shadow day to gain additional knowledge and insight into the school from a student's perspective. These shadow opportunities are structured to give eighth graders a glimpse of high school courses and meet the faculty. Each student is matched with a current SMCHS student who has similar academic and co-curricular interests. Shadow days will be November 5, November 6, November 12, and November 13 and will run from 7:45 a.m.-11:10 a.m.

There is an additional opportunity for parents and students to experience SMCHS on Monday, October 15 at SMCHS Information Night. Parents and students will meet faculty, guidance department staff, and administration. Guided tours of the facility will be provided along with an overview of student life at SMCHS.
