D. Athletic Director Report HS – Adam Bates

- Softball:
 - Softball received a 3-seed in the playoffs and hosted Reedsville, the 6-seed, in the Regional Semifinal Game on Tuesday, May 22. SMC beat Reedsville 4-3 to advance to the Regional Final. SMC played Algoma on May 25 and lost 7-3 to end their season. Hosted the Sectional Final between Weyauwega-Fremont and Manitowoc Lutheran that went really well. Ended up making about \$3000 between gate and concessions (also had Regional Baseball and Regional Soccer that night too).

- Baseball:
 - SMC hosted the Regional Semifinal Game on Tuesday, May 29 and played Reedsville. SMC won 2-1.
 - SMC hosted Bonduel on Wednesday, May 30 in the Regional Final game. The SMCHS Baseball team beat Bonduel 3-2 last night to win the Regional Championship and advance to the Sectional!
 - We hosted the Sectional on Tuesday, June 5. Game schedule was as follows:
 - 12:00pm – Sectional Semifinal Game 1
 - Marathon vs. Pacelli (Marathon won 6-3)
 - 3:00pm – Sectional Semifinal Game 2
 - Coleman vs. SMC (SMC won 7-2)
 - 6:00pm – Sectional Final
 - Marathon vs. SMC (SMC won 6-2)
 - Made about \$4000 between gate and concessions
 - The Baseball team beat Coleman 7-2 in the Sectional Semifinal and beat Marathon 6-2 in the Sectional Final to win the Sectional Championship and advance to State!
 - We played Mineral Point on Wednesday, June 13 at 1:00pm in the first game of the Division 3 Semifinal Session at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium! Lost to Webster 8-2 in the State Final to become Division 3 State Runner's Up!
 - The SMCS Booster Club sponsored a tailgate from 10:30am – 12:00pm in the parking lot at Fox Cities Stadium prior to the Baseball game on Wednesday, June 13. The Booster Club provided hot dogs, burgers, buns, chips, cookies and drinks. Attendees brought their own chairs. Cash donations were received.

- Golf:
 - The Golf Team finished 2nd at the Varsity Regional meet. The team advanced to the Sectional meet at Central Wisconsin Christian on Tuesday, May 29.

- The team finished 5th place with a score of 355 at the Sectional. Golfers: Grant Boyson, Ethan Watt, Joseph Holschuh, Elizabeth Rosiejka and Wyatt Bittner. Grant Boyson finished in the top 3 and qualified for State as an individual.
- Grant Boyson shot a second-round 77 at State to finish in a four-way tie for sixth place with a total of 156. Only two shots away from a top-five finish and six-shots behind the individual champion.
- Track
 - Boys 4x800 M Relay team of Joseph Porter, Grant Dejno, Tip Hogerty and Ethan Unruh finished 3rd place with a time of 8:29.68 at the Sectional and qualified for State Track Meet.
 - At State, the team set a new school record of 8:19:45 and finished in 3rd place.
- Boys Tennis:
 - Jack Hageman qualified for the Varsity Tennis Sectional. Lost in sectionals to David Horak from Xavier.
- Girls Soccer:
 - The team received a 2-seed in the playoffs and hosted Arcadia/Independence, the 7-seed, on Thursday, May 31 in the Regional Semifinal Game! SMC won 11-0 to advance to the Regional Final.
 - SMC beat Newman Catholic 7-0 @ home on Saturday, June 2 in the Regional Final game. Regional Champs! SMC advances to the Sectionals.
 - SMC lost to Aquinas 3-1 in the Sectional Semifinal game.
