# **Curriculum**

Teachers from all levels, elementary / middle / high school, completed summer work becoming
familiar with the new Social Studies curriculum. During the course of this school year, those teachers
along with others will work with principal leaders to develop grade level themes for consistency
between all schools. Materials will also be reviewed this year and will include a recommendation for
material updates for next school year in the area of Social Studies.

#### **Professional Development**

- All principals and our director of educational compliance attended a leadership workshop in Milwaukee in July. Concepts will be placed on the principal's monthly meeting agendas for follow up to assure that the knowledge gained is implemented into practice.
- All teachers and administrators attended Diocesan Discipleship training prior to the start of the school year.
- A speaker from CESA 6 presented a motivational workshop on building relationships and culture with individual schools as well as within our system.
- Following last year's faculty faith formation using the Alpha program, we'll be moving to the "Following Christ" component this year. There will be two half-day retreats for all faculty on November 4<sup>th</sup> and March 20<sup>th</sup>. Additional staff will be invited to attend if they desire.
- On September 30<sup>th</sup>, elementary and middle school teachers will continue their work in the area of literacy and all staff will work on effectiveness practices including student learning goals.
