<u>Advancement – Fund Development</u>

Zephyrs Gold – Information for Zephyrs Gold raffle will be found in our SMCS newsletter 8/19. This parent letter introduces the raffle to our system and encourages selling tickets outside of the family to offset the fundraising fee. Shifting this raffle to an all-cash prize raffle, we anticipate selling more tickets than previous years. Tickets will be sold from 8/28 until 10/21, with the first drawing on 10/23. If the COVID environment clears up, we will use the drawing nights to create Zephyrs excitement and community builders.

Annual Fund Appeal 2020-2021 — Our Advancement Team met to plan for the scope and sequence of our upcoming annual appeal. The strategies, timeline, marketing material, modes of communication and new ways to connect with alumni were mapped out. The specific focus that will help achieve our goal of \$200,000 is an emphasis on alumni relationship building with graduates from the 2000's. The percentage of these alumni that give is very low. Casting a vision that small gifts matter will be appealing to this demographic.

Grand Opening & Zephyrs Connect – The postponement of high school sporting events, soccer and football respectively, was the pivot to combine the grand opening or our new athletic fields with the Zephyrs Connect event (formerly Connect 5). Bishop Ricken will perform the Rite of Blessing. There will be fun for the kids, highlighting of four varsity athletic teams, ceremonial "first passes/hand-offs", and fireworks to cap the evening. Interest and excitement is very high, with over 300 currently registered to attend. A reminder that our Board of Trustees, SMCS Foundation Board and Parish Leaders are cordially invited to the August 28th evening. Please RSVP so we can prepare for physical distancing and food preparation!

Grants – We will be applying for six (6) grants from local foundations within the next 30 days. These grants should help offset costs of COVID related expenses, such as training for teachers to grow in their virtual teaching abilities, costs to keep our facilities safe, help offset co-curricular fees for students and provide funding to teach financial literacy for HS students and families within our system. Grants received since July:

- Toyota and Lexus grants (\$10,000 each) with a Bergstrom match to fund the new sound/speaker systems = \$40,000 total
- A grant from an anonymous donor within the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region, Inc. to fund our STEM Club = \$10,605
