

SMCS Board of Trustees President's Report November 18, 2020

Business Services: Finance/Technology/Food Service

- Collaborated with Admissions to select a new system that will handle our enrollment, tuition management, and accounting systems
 - Will begin to transition to Blackbaud for these systems
 - Systems will allow for families to enroll, register, and manage their tuition payments and other fees all in one place
 - \circ $\;$ Will also allow for a seamless transition from the parents' side to the business side
 - New system will provide an accounting system that is built for schools, which will allow for better expense management tools and better reporting tools
 - \circ $\;$ Will also provide a platform to more easily work with the auditors in the future
 - President signed contract for this investment; \$34,250 for year 1, \$30,000/year for year 2 & 3
- Working with the Finance Committee on tuition and budget projections for 2021-22
- Working with BOT Treasurer on new reporting system and chart of accounts
- WPCP financial audit finalized and submitted to DPI on October 8
- Now providing CLA information and documents on the WPCP enrollment audit
- Facilitating a SCRIP fundraiser for all three boys basketball teams
- Partnering with Brigade and Parishes to refer SMCS families for Christmas giving programs

Advancement – Fund Development

Annual Appeal 2020-2021

- "I'm INspired" campaign has launched with a physical mailer sent to 620 alumni or past donors
- Also addressed and sent an additional 115 mailers to the top 10% of supporters from last year
- Balance of donor database to receive the campaign material digitally through direct emails and newsletters
- Preparing to capitalize on Giving Tuesday (December 1) and drive donations to the annual appeal
