Rudd graduated with his bachelor’s degree in philosophy from Conception Seminary College in Missouri in 2017, as well as completed studies at Creighton University Institute for Priestly Formation, San José Priory (Guatemala) Spanish Immersion Program and the University of Wisconsin — Oshkosh. He also spent a year as a missionary with Spiritus Ministries based in Menasha. Rudd is a 2011 graduate of Lourdes Academy in Oshkosh.

“I have a passion for both Catholic schools and parish ministry, as a former Catholic school student and a former parish employee,” Rudd said. “My new position as director of ministry at SMCS enables me to work in the best of both of these worlds.”
