Matt Schoultz discussion on returning to 11-man football

- o 2024 fall earliest to get back into 11-man football
  - No other school wants to switch
  - Need full approval to get back in
  - o The CWC league is short on teams and may allow SMC in
    - Positive feedback for introduction in fall of 2024
    - Need to send in an application by Oct of 2022
    - Not eligible for playoffs in the current league
    - May try an 11-man playoff in 2023 as transition

- Number of players has increase dramatically
  - Likely over 50 in program on the team, so 11-man would be preferable
  - Co-op with the New Hope Christian Academy good for one more year.
    May leave on their own since they may have 20 by themselves
  - Matt feels ready to transition to 11-man
  - Lots of change for a successful team
  - About 35 needed for an 11-man team
  - Last year we played two 11-man games
  - Will play at least one game this year
  - A lot of progress has been made and Matt is confident we can support a successful 11-man team.
  - Would be in the large CWC team conference
  - Some concern by the conference that we are recruiting students for sports.

- Superintendent report
  - Highlighted from report
  - Realignment of elementary school principals
    - Dan has been contacting or had contact with concerned individuals
    - Some teachers have resigned due to change
    - 5 directly due to change, 3 more for other reasons
    - Support other visions and will let go
    - Good moral amongst the remaining staff
    - Lots of energy at St. Mary's
    - No children involved in support or not of change
    - Been gaining higher quality staff to replace lost staff
      - Most candidates are Catholic
      - A lot of transition from public schools.
    - Anna is very good, Dan is very happy with her
    - Some candidates were recommended by current staff
    - One by one campaign used to level the teacher salary
    - Some rumblings that we are spending more on facilities than teachers
      - Donors invest in facilities and not as much on teachers
    - Teachers usually more satisfied in the private schools versus public
    - July 1 is start date for 22/23 school year.
    - Current projection is 964, started at 949, not finished
      - Likely more students will be coming
      - Net grow before the start of the school yar
      - Estimating 975
      - Budget based on 974
      - Choice and high school heavy

- Better retention of 8<sup>th</sup> graders this year
- Summer camp registration is good
  - There are electives available for camp
- Annual fund budget was met
- Zepyrfest budget was amazing also
- Received a Shippek fund distribution for another \$100,000
  - Computer crash will likely use all of the Shippek fund distribution for preventative measures for servers and routers
  - First infrastructure is likely the first failure, had been bandaging for quite a while
  - Need to support all technologies with new system
  - Router is the bottle neck and second is servers
  - Uninterruptable power supply to allow for enough time to shut down all systems. Old system only had a 10 min backup capability. Now we will have enough time to shut everything down
    - o Phil to find out exactly how much time there is
  - Local network storage, expandable to 192 tera bytes
    - Cloud storage also being used
    - About \$15,000 of server upgrade for regular service
    - Next step is to budget out costs to maintain all.
  - Need to discuss this further to assure minimum chance of reoccurrence
    - May need to outsource
    - Has there been a report sent out on the full impact of the shutdown? That way we will know what the potential change may be
- Finance committee
  - Clarify comments in finance committee report questions
    - Director of business services has been filled
    - Can't use formal system to generate reports
      - o Transitioning to black baud
      - Jamie has the experience to use this
        - That was lost with her
    - Parental choice program on track/budget
      - Heavier mix of high school students
      - May have more funds available, since some families that had been using donations can apply for Choice
    - Kristin felt obligated to show movement of money to markets that will make the school money versus just sitting there
    - Bill has done a great job at managing the finance committee
    - Kirsten has done a great job covering for Jamie
  - Committee reports are available for review
    - Get strategic plan ready
    - Finishing charters
    - Work to do yet, Bill is working on
