PRESENTATION OF SCHOOL TESTING RESULTS

- From Kelly
 - Wisconsin education standards recently updated, SMCS was updated as well
 - Renaissance Star is new testing method per Diocese for the elementary school system
 - Wisconsin forward exam was given to choice students
 - ACT given to junior high school students
 - AP testing in the spring
 - Difference with ACT is there must be a writing sample, only required by the state and not given to the colleges
 - 75% option out of the ACT
 - Renaissance Star
 - Test difficulty based on how the student answers
 - Kelly shared test result data
 - This year is a data collection year and used as a baseline for the Diocese
 - o Ron wanted to know if there is a comparison to use.

- Renaissance Star is not used for most schools in the area, so there is some difficulty in comparing
- Only use for Catholic schools in the Diocese
- Shorter test can cause more error
- Committed to use Renaissance Star for the next 3 years
- Difficult to cross compare to other test methods
- Some disparity between results compared to testing done last year
- Kelly working on getting additional information on how to best present the gathered information
- Some useful data is being gathered for the teachers
 - Too confusing to share with parents at this point
- Kelly starting to plot the data (only one point right now)
- May have an open forum to explain the Renaissance Star testing method to parents
- Would like to see testing and results earlier
- Wisconsin Forward
 - Very comparable results
 - No gains or falls
 - Percentage gets thrown off due to small class size
 - Using data to find gaps in learning to update teachers
 - Wisconsin Forward will be completely redone and new benchmarks will be generated
 - Not good for comparing old data
- ACT
 - Slightly above state average
 - Wide range of scores that averages out to be a little better
 - o ACT is a national test and no comparison to Wisconsin students can be made

FINANCE

- Kristen
 - Discussion of phase two of the SMCHS project
 - Donor giving money over time and renovate STEM building to lockers/training/classroom
 - Donor pledged a total of \$400,000
 - Received an initial payment of \$66,667
 - Have some funding available
 - BOT being asked to approve project going forward
 - With BOT approval, will move forward for approval from the Diocese
 - For Diocesan approval, SMCS needs BOT approval
- Meghan Healy moved to request authorization from the Diocese to move forward with the project
- Second by Ron Schreier
- Call to vote unanimous

Motion carried

- o May need to draw a line of credit due to timing of donor funding
- Project has not started yet
- WPCP audit was reviewed for policy on what education projects can be funded
 - As part of audit, it was noted our policy on what is defined as an education cost needed to be updated.
 - Revised policy compliant with WPCP policy was voted on by Finance committee and unanimously approved.
- Dr. David DeWitt moved to allow for a draw on the line of credit to complete project
- Second by Troy Noel
- Call to vote unanimous

BUDGET

- Tracking to modified budget
 - o Dr. David DeWitt commented on some costs are seasonal
 - Travel and training poorly estimated
- Format driven money for playoff games
 - Only get concession money
 - Rest goes to WIAA
 - Hosting does bring in some additional money that goes to Matt's AD fund
- Cash flow discussion
 - There will be a release of funds (Miller particularly)
 - About \$600,000 in December
 - Finance committee met twice this month
 - Moving to a 10-year budget
 - "What if" scenarios being generated
 - Working on how to's on balancing budget
 - Goal to submit a balanced budget
 - Not quite there yet
 - The process highlights need for Momentum campaign
 - Parish investment has historically been a larger percentage of total revenue, but will not be as much going forward (currently a static amount)
 - Also, trying to get closer to paying teachers near public schools' salary

UPDATED METRICS ON STRATEGIC PLAN

- No questions on the Google Docs document
 - Some of the metrics do not have goals
 - Working to improve
 - Gave some gaps in the completion dates to ease the influx of answers
 - o Should be able to come up with better metrics as we move forward
 - Would like to normally have done before the school year begins
- Will vote on in December
- Strategic plan will continue to be updated every year

FOUNDATION UPDATE

- Talking about Momentum
 - Foundation excited about Momentum
 - o Josh Dietrich new member on foundation board
 - Ryan's term on the foundation board will be completed at the end of the year
- Fundraising consultants finishing in April
- Discussing with potential donors
- Some high dollar ask outs
- · Asking donors to make SMCS part of their estate

PRESIDENTS REPORT

- o Talked about foundation a little
- Update on the last month
- Highlighting
 - Hired a 5th grade teacher
 - Previous candidates had not been strong candidates
 - Hired an excellent teacher
 - Good first impression
- Hired a math consultant (about \$3000, covered by a donor)
 - To spend time in elementary classes and come up with some findings
 - How are we reaching kids
 - Should be interesting and useful results
 - Will use results to advise on revised math delivery
- Working on calendar
 - Adding Diocesan events
- Vicker meeting at the Diocese
 - Update on how to approve capital campaigns to be shared with the Diocese
- Kathleen McCurdy really working out well

 - Need to get approved
