EARLY CHILDHOOD & ELEMENTARY

The SMCS Early Childhood Program provides a Catholic environment and fosters positive values and attitudes. Warm and engaging teachers nurture the spiritual, emotional, intellectual, social and physical developmental growth of each young student. Our teachers cultivate each student's natural curiosity for learning and encourage self-motivation and independence, promoting an awareness and acceptance of each person's uniqueness.

St. Mary Catholic Schools elementary curriculum includes a strong foundation in the traditional elements of a well-rounded education. Students are immersed in literacy, math, science, and social studies guided in Catholic values, nurtured in education and encouraged in personal development. Special courses, including music, art, physical education, world language and school counseling, offer students an opportunity to explore new ideas and experiences in areas that reach beyond the basic curriculum.

SMCS Measures of Academic Program (MAP) scores in grades 1-7 consistently rank well above national norm averages in all disciplines, and are among the highest in the area.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

St. Mary Catholic Schools educators form teaching and learning teams, ensuring that the curriculum is shared and reinforced across grade levels and disciplines. We offer a challenging, hands-on and exploratory curriculum, as well as intensive classes at each level for students who are ready to delve deeper. Students may also earn high school credit while in middle school.

Our middle school building stands alone in its layout, which is designed to promote collaborative learning and interactivity, while providing state-of-the-art technology.

HIGH SCHOOL



St. Mary Catholic Schools incorporates technology into a strong, college-prep curriculum. We offer a wide variety of courses, including numerous AP and CAPP courses, as well as an array of business and fine arts classes.

We are proud to share that our high school's ACT scores are consistently above local, state, and national averages, and 33% of students in the Class of 2019 were awarded Advanced Placement (AP) Scholar designation.

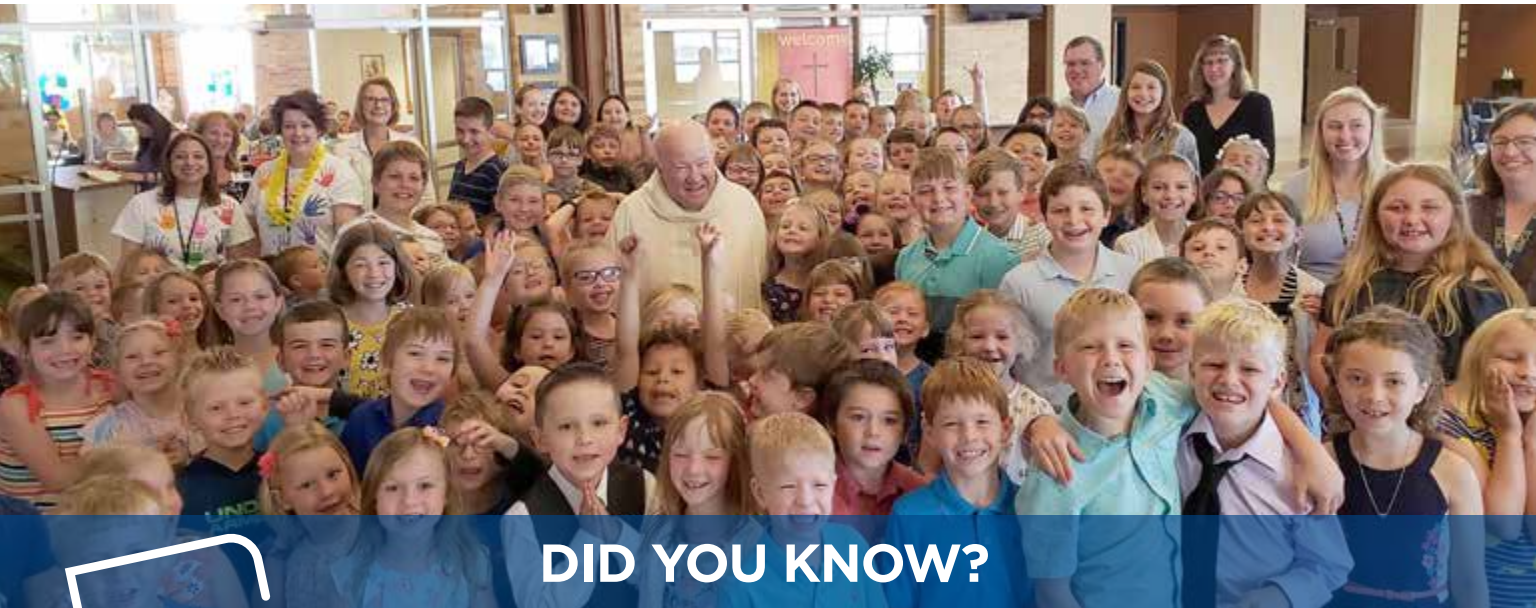

THEOLOGY

The SMCS family is a faith-based community that nurtures the spiritual lives of students, families, faculty and staff. A variety of faith opportunities are present to encourage the community to worship and pray together. Each school actively promotes social justice experiences as an integral part of the school, and all SMCS schools are welcoming, inclusive and safe for all who enter our doors.

Our theology curriculum helps our students grow spiritually in the Catholic faith, reinforces their moral growth and teaches them to reach out beyond themselves in the community. We strive to nurture a deep faith in our students and to educate the Church leaders of tomorrow. Our theological studies are aligned with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) guidelines. It is also the foundation of the co-curricular philosophy and expectations.

SERVICE

We feel it is important for our students, as a faithful student body, to be the hands and feet of Christ in today's world. We require all of our middle and high school students to complete service hours each year. Students in early childhood through fifth grade participate in service activities with their classmates.

FACILITIES

SMCS is blessed to have regulation competition fields for many high school sports on the combined high school and middle school campus. A grass football and soccer field, beautiful tennis courts and a full baseball diamond and softball field provide a home-field advantage to our Zephyrs teams. The high school's McClone Gymnasium and the double gym at St. Mary Catholic Middle School provide a terrific, multi-court venue for hosting indoor sports competitions and practices. Each elementary school has a full gym available for athletics, enrichment activities and physical education classes.

The SMCS Fitness Center provides a phenomenal place for students in grades 6-12 to develop their athletic skills and lifelong fitness habits.

SMCS gives students opportunities to explore their artistic interests. Through our curriculum and co-curriculars, we give all students the chance to explore their passions, abilities and gifts.

Students who participate in fine arts activities perform well academically, manage their time well and appreciate culture and arts. As part of a well-rounded education, SMCS encourages students to explore their talents in visual, vocal and instrumental fine arts, as well as theater and forensic performance. Whether part of the curriculum or as co-curricular opportunities, fine arts at St. Mary Catholic Schools is a valued educational experience.



ART, MUSIC & DRAMA

Our elementary schools offer art and music classes that include singing, dancing and learning to play instruments. Concert band and after-school enrichment activities such as dance, art, singing and strings are also available. Middle and high school courses and activities include many instrumental and vocal groups, forensics, graphic arts and visual arts classes.

The SMCS state-of-the-art Jane Bergstrom Fine Arts Education Center (FAEC) is enjoyed by the entire SMCS community. The venue is used by students and staff from the five SMCS schools, as well as alumni and community members for concerts, performances and events. It is modeled after the same advanced, professional technology used by the Fox Cities Performing Arts Center with the intent of exposing our students to opportunities in all aspects of the fine arts. It includes state-of-the-art audiovisual, lighting and production equipment, a staging fly system and Yamaha grand piano. The facility also includes a set-building studio and costume shop, as well as a comfortable green room. Students enjoy developing their talents in both onstage and behind-the-scenes roles.

AQUINAS PROGRAM

The SMCS Aquinas Program, located within the St. Mary Elementary Campus of St. Mary Catholic Schools, meets the educational aspirations of students in grades 3-5, who will thrive in an environment with a self-directed and inter-disciplinary model of instruction. The SMCS Aquinas Program is a project-based, accelerated curriculum, takes place in a multi-age classroom and is led by a teacher who is certified in gifted-and-talented education.

The program is open to students who complete the assessment process and are admitted into the program. Potential participants have demonstrated the ability to set and work towards goals and to take responsibility for their learning by working independently.



TECHNOLOGY

Our students use state-of-the-art technology. From tablets, computers and smart boards to our one-to-one laptop program starting in sixth grade, our students benefit from technology that enhances our curriculum and prepares them for our ever changing world.

A dedicated IT staff is committed to helping ensure that all of our students' needs are met, without interruption.



WORLD LANGUAGES & CULTURE

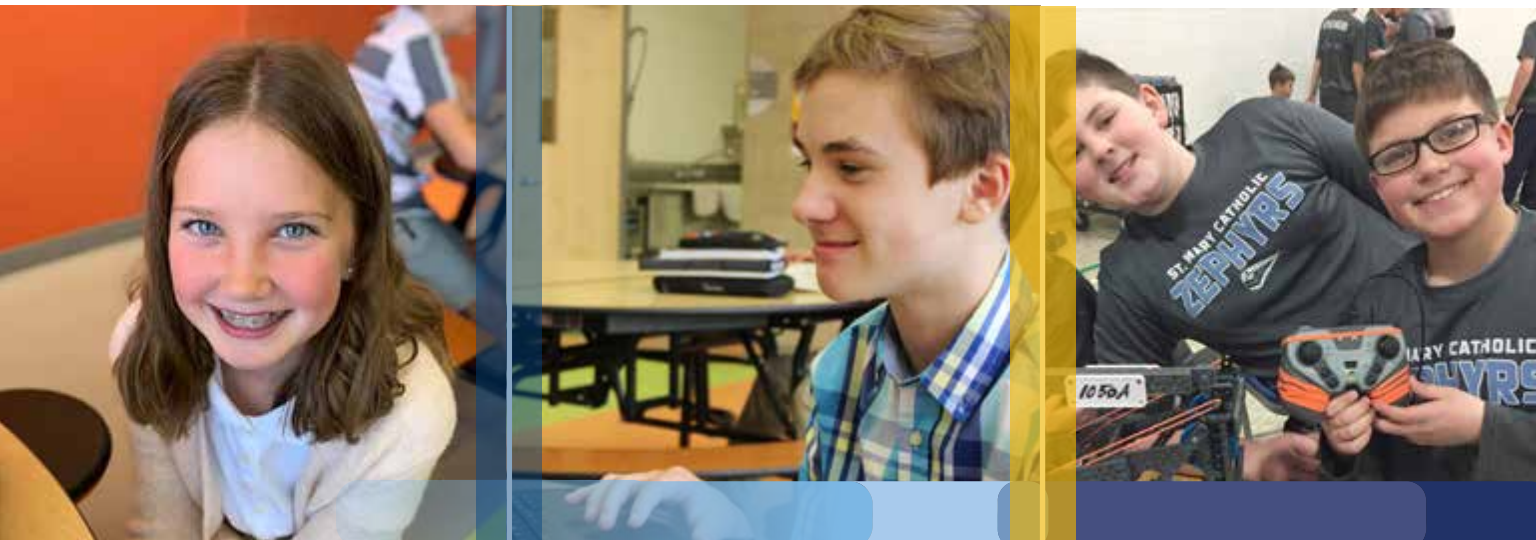
SMCS is proud to offer three world languages – German, Mandarin Chinese and Spanish. As part of a global society, SMCS realizes the importance of communicating with and appreciating the cultures of others. STEM & PLTW



SMCS is committed to a STEM-based curriculum at all grade levels. Many co-curricular opportunities, including our nationally recognized VEX Robotics program, support this focus from kindergarten through high school. Project Lead The Way (PLTW), the nation's leading provider of K-12 STEM programs, supplements the SMCS science curriculum. Its project-based curriculum and high-quality teacher professional development, combined with an engaged network of educators and corporate partners, helps students develop the skills they need to be successful in post-secondary education and beyond. Our program includes “Launch” (elementary), “Gateway” (middle school) and “Pathways” (high school) components.
