This project takes electric cars that young children commonly have, and then customize them to fit the needs of children with difficulties in ambulation, that limit their abilities to explore the world around them. In two of the cars shown here, they replaced the "gas" pedal with a button on the steering wheel to propel the car to make it easier for the kids to drive. Each car also has a remote control for the parents, which has priority over what the child does to help keep them safe and help them turn. Alec's favorite part of this project was working in tandem with the engineering students, and seeing the big smiles from the kids and parents when they brought the cars to their houses.
