Students are to prepare a short song selection and a short monologue, each 1 minute or less. It is highly recommended that students sing something in the style of musical theater. Students are welcome to sing a song from Junie B. Jones or any other musical (No accompaniment needed.) Comfort and confidence are the most important things to showcase. Therefore, if a student is not comfortable preparing a song from a musical, they are encouraged to sing Happy Birthday or Silent Night. Monologues can be taken from past forensic pieces, movies, books, plays, or even created. The purpose is to show how comfortable and confident the student is on stage, so content is much less important than presentation.
