Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP)

Application Period: First weekday in February through Third Thursday in April

SMCS participated in this program through the Department of Public Instruction that allows 4K through grade 12 students to attend a private school if eligibility criteria are met.

SMCS Tuition Assistance

Application Period: February 1 through March 15
